# 50 DAYS of FOCUSED PRAYER

Specific prayer welcomes

Holy Spirit empowerment is increasingly bubbling up in local Wesleyan churches of all sizes and in all contexts who are developing **ACTS 1:8** visions. While The Wesleyan Church (TWC) has many fully **ACTS 1:8** churches, every TWC church can be equipped for prayer and be resourced to develop their own kingdom ripple effect.

This prayer guide provides a daily Bible verse, quote or song to prompt your reflection. It then gives you a suggested prayer focus — a need or opportunity. You’ll notice as it flows through the 50 days, it follows the progression of **ACTS 1:8**. Initial days focus on Holy Spirit empowerment, for the purposes of all disciples being witnesses, which permeates one’s community (Jerusalem), locations beyond that are similar or different (Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth).

The geography is joined by the recurring word “and” — it is not “or” as if we choose just one, but “and” so the gospel flows to all. Jerusalem at the time of Jesus was a city within the broader immediate area long known as Judea, but under Roman rule the province of Judea contained Samaria as well. Another way of thinking about it, the **ACTS 1:8** promise includes “here, near, far ... no matter how hard.”

You’ll notice an opportunity for individuals to “pray on offense” for very specific everyday places and people at home, their workplace or other settings where they have friendships and opportunity for influence.

“The 50 Days of Focused Prayer” guide is designed to help you sense how God is leading you to pray each day ... may you have freedom to hear and follow the promptings of the Holy Spirit!

### **FRESH FILLING AND POWER**

Our first focus is on the power God makes available for his purposes to be accomplished. The Holy Spirit does not give us power to accomplish our own selfish desires nor does God expect us to fulfill his purposes in our power. We need the empowering and filling of the Holy Spirit to be personally transformed and to be witnesses to others. So, for the first several days, you’ll pray for the empowerment and filling of your church and your life as guided by Scripture, quotes and songs all pointing to the person and power of the Holy Spirit.

## DAYS

# 1-10

### DAY 1

**ACTS 1:8** But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

*As you reflect on this verse, what stands out to you? How are you prompted to pray (it may mean simply turning this verse into a prayer that you offer to God)?*

### DAY 2

**ZECHARIAH 4:6** So he said to me, “This is the word of the LORD to Zerubbabel: ‘Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit,’ says the LORD Almighty.”

*As you reflect on this verse, what stands out to you? How are you prompted to pray?*

### DAY 3

**TITUS 3:5-6** He saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior.

*As you reflect on this verse, what stands out to you? How are you prompted to pray?*

### DAY 4

Trying to do the Lord’s work in your own strength is the most confusing, exhausting, and tedious of all work. But when you are filled with the Holy Spirit, then the ministry of Jesus just flows out of you. The human spirit fails, except when the Holy Spirit fills.

### DAY 5

And hope does not put us to shame, because God’s love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.

*As you reflect on this verse, what stands out to you? How are you prompted to pray?*

### DAY 10

If we think of the Holy Spirit only as an impersonal power or influence, then our thought will constantly be, how can I get hold of and use the Holy Spirit; but if we think of Him in the biblical way as a divine Person, infinitely wise, infinitely holy, infinitely tender, then our thought will constantly be, *‘How can the Holy Spirit get hold of and use me?’*

### YOUR JERUSALEM ACTS 1:8

*But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem ...*

By the time of Jesus, the name Jerusalem not only included the city and its surrounding suburbs, towns and villages, but also came to represent a district of Judea. Herod's massive construction projects would have been taking place throughout the city, adding to the hustle and bustle of everyday life. Population estimates are from 600,000 (Roman historian Tacitus) to over a million (Josephus).

### DAY 21

### YOUR JUDEA ACTS 1:8

*But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea ...*

The geographical region of ancient Judea at the time of Jesus originally encompassed the territory of the tribe of Judah and later of the ancient kingdom of Judah (Southern Kingdom in OT). Judea lost its independence to the Romans in the 1st century B.C., by becoming first a tributary kingdom of the Roman Empire, then a Roman province incorporating Judea, Samaria and Idumea. More specifically, it was the broader region in which the city of Jerusalem was located.

DAY 31

**YOUR SAMARIA ACTS 1:8**

*But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria ...*

During the time of Jesus, Samaria was located between Galilee to the north and Judea to the south. Today, Samaria is in what is now the northern West Bank. The Jews of Jesus' day disliked the Samaritans because of their religious syncretism and their mixed racial heritage. Samaria is included in receiving a witness to the gospel **ACTS 1:8**. Once the church was scattered after Stephen's martyrdom, many Christians fled to the surrounding areas, including Samaria (Acts 8:1, 5-6). As a region, Samaria was significant in the Old Testament as being synonymous with the Northern Kingdom and in the New Testament as an idolatrous area Jews tried to avoid. Despite Samaria's checkered history and the Jews' general dislike of the people of the region, Jesus himself evangelized the area and mandated that the gospel be preached there after his ascension.

DAY 32

**MATTHEW 3:11** "I baptize you with water for repentance. But after me comes one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire."

*Is there a portion of your community, or one with driving distance, that is viewed as being unique? Perhaps like Samaria, it is different religiously or culturally? Pause to pray for them.*

DAY 33

**2 CORINTHIANS 13:14** May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

*Who do you know who lives in that community? Are these individuals who are yet to commit their lives to Christ? Pray for them right now.*

DAY 34
